- Max and Arnaud reinvented a centuries-old tradition from Ethiopia and developed the new recipe of Coffee Leaf Tea on the farm in Nicaragua.

Social Impact & Goals

Coffee farms are only profitable during the bean harvest season, which is only 3-4 months long. 80-90% of the workers are seasonal and seek work elsewhere during the off-season, creating a very volatile economy.
